GENERAL

These rules are not comprehensive and must, at all times, be read in conjunction with the WDF Playing and Tournament Rules and Bye-Laws (<https://www.dartswdf.com/rules/>).

1. WDF YOUTH CALENDAR

A list of all sanctioned WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments can be found on the WDF website by visiting <https://www.dartswdf.com/calendar>.

2. WDF YOUTH RANKED TOURNAMENTS

2.01 Dart's tournaments promoted, or organised by WDF Member Bodies may be ranked, providing that they comply with the following guidelines:

- a) Only 'singles' darts tournaments, or 'singles' events of tournaments shall be ranked.
- b) WDF Member Darts Bodies may offer Boys only, Girls only or Mixed Boys and Girls ranked tournaments.
- c) All WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments must be "open" to the Playing Members of all WDF Member Darts Bodies, providing that they meet the eligibility requirements of the event in question (see WDF Bye-Law 2.01 - <https://www.dartswdf.com/rules/>).
- d) Players must be under the age of 18 on December 31 to compete in any WDF Ranked Youth tournaments in the next WDF season, (January 1 to December 31), and any major tournament associated to that season.
- e) Current PDC Tour Card holders cannot take part in any WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.

2.02 Only WDF Member Darts Bodies may apply for WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.

2.03 In any calendar year Member Darts Bodies may apply for a maximum of sixteen Boys and six Girls OR sixteen Mixed WDF Youth Ranking Tournaments with no more than two Boys and two Girls OR two Mixed Tournaments at each Sanctioned Event.

2.04 All WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments must be promoted and organised by a WDF Member Darts Body or its agreed appointed organisers, providing that they are an integral part of the WDF Member Darts Body.

2.05 The WDF Executive will assess each application for a WDF Youth Ranked Tournament on its merits and reserve the right to include or exclude any tournament in the WDF Youth Ranking Systems Criteria.

3. RANKING CRITERIA

3.01 A WDF Ranked Youth Event must have at least two participants to receive ranking points.

3.02 Where there are less than four boys and/or less than four girls, it is permitted to arrange a "mixed" event that includes boys and girls.

- In such mixed events ranking points will be allocated in the same way as in a normal boys' or girls' event.

- 3.03 WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments will be given an initial grading of Gold, Silver or Bronze based on the total number of participants in the previous edition of the tournament.
- The same grading will be awarded to both boys and girls tournaments based on the total number of participants in both tournaments combined
- 3.04 New WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments will be awarded Bronze grading.
- 3.05 Gold grading will be awarded to tournaments that had 65 or more participants, (boys and girls combined), in the previous edition of the tournament.
- 3.06 Initial Silver grading will be awarded to tournaments that had between 17 and 64 participants, (boys and girls combined), in the previous edition of the tournament,
- 3.07 Initial Bronze grading will be awarded to tournaments that had between 2 and 16 participants, (boys and girls combined), in the previous edition of the tournament.
- 3.08 Once initial grading has been awarded, that grading cannot be reduced.
- 3.09 A tournament can be upgraded if, on the day that the draw takes place, entries reach the next level.
- For example, a tournament is initially awarded silver grading based on their being 55 entries the previous year. At the time the draw is made there are 66 entries. The tournament would be upgraded to gold grading.

4. TOURNAMENT APPLICATIONS

- 4.01 Applications for tournament dates and grading should be made by the Principal Contact completing the following form <https://forms.gle/E8qv5Cq2kRLBWHWL9>.
- 4.02 Member Darts Bodies should complete Tournament Application forms no later than three months before tournaments are scheduled to take place.
- a) Tournament Applications must contain requested tournament dates.
 - b) Tournament Applications will be reviewed, and Member Countries informed of confirmed dates within twenty-one days of receipt of the Tournament Application form.

5. TOURNAMENT SANCTION FEES

- 5.01 WDF Sanctioning Fees will not be charged for WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.

6. PLAYER LEVY

- 6.01 WDF Player Levies will not be charged for WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.

7. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 7.01 Tournament Organisers shall submit Tournament Information around all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments to the WDF Sports Administrator a minimum of eight weeks before the Sanctioned Event begins.
- 7.02 All Tournament Information shall be made available on the WDF Youth Calendar at the earliest opportunity.

- 7.03 The Tournament Information shall include, but shall not be limited to:
- (a) The postal address and location of the Sanctioned Event.
 - (b) The date of each WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
 - (c) The grading for each WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
 - (d) How to enter, the entry fee and deadline for entry for each tournament.
 - Including a link to online entry where applicable.
 - An entry form shall be included if online registration is not included.
 - (e) The WDF Anti-Doping and Drinking statements.
 - (f) The playing format for each WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
 - (g) A complete breakdown of the prize money (if applicable) for each WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
 - Entry fees and prize money shall be listed in the same currency.
- 7.04 Tournament Organisers are encouraged to offer accommodation packages to attending players.

8. TOURNAMENT ENTRY AND FEES

- 8.01 Each individual may only enter each tournament once.
- 8.02 Entry fees for WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall not exceed the equivalent to 50.00 USD.
- 8.03 Should any WDF Youth Ranked Tournament be cancelled before its commencement, the Member Darts Body will be responsible for returning all entry fees.
- The WDF will not accept any responsibility or liability for any costs incurred should any tournament be cancelled
- 8.04 It is the Tournament Organisers responsibility to ensure that only eligible players enter a WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
- Any ineligible players that enter a WDF Youth Ranked Tournament in error shall have their entry fee returned and shall not be entered into the draw.

9. TOURNAMENT SEEDING AND DRAW

- 9.01 WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall be seeded based on the initial grading awarded as a part of the Tournament Application process and shall be seeded in the following way:
- a) Gold graded tournaments shall carry 16 seeds.
 - b) Silver graded tournaments shall carry 8 seeds.
 - c) Bronze graded tournaments shall carry 4 seeds.
- 9.02 Seeding shall be taken from the WDF Main Ranking Tables (See section 15).
- Where not enough players or not enough WDF Youth ranked players enter a WDF Youth Ranked Tournament to allow for a full complement of seeds, the number of seeds shall be reduced to 8, 4, 2 or 0 as required.

Tournament seedings shall be based on the WDF Youth Main Ranking Table positions on the penultimate Wednesday before a Sanctioned Event commences.

For example, for a Sanctioned Event that commences on Saturday 29 January, seedings shall be taken from the WDF Youth Main Ranking Tables on Wednesday 19 January.

9.03 Seeding shall be applied at the time that entries to the tournament close.

Where players are tied in the WDF Youth Main Ranking Table, the player that has the highest individual scoring points box shall be seeded highest.

For example:

Player A

- Highest scoring box - 180 points
- Second highest scoring box - 90 points
- Third highest scoring box - 90 points
- Fourth highest scoring box - 28 points
- Total = 388 points

Player B

- Highest scoring box - 180 points
- Second highest scoring box - 180 points
- Third highest scoring box - 17 points
- Fourth highest scoring box - 11 points
- Total = 388 points

Player B would be seeded highest as their second highest scoring box is higher than Player A's second highest scoring box.

Where players remain tied, a draw will take place to determine the higher seeded player.

9.04 Seeds shall be distributed through the draw in sections, as detailed below, with each section being of equal size.

a) For two seeds the draw shall be split into two sections. Each seed shall be placed at the top of a section in the following order:

- 1,2

b) For four seeds the draw shall be split into four sections. Each seed shall be placed at the top of a section in the following order:

- 1,4,2,3

c) For eight seeds the draw shall be split into eight sections. Each seed shall be placed at the top of a section in the following order:

- 1,8,4,5,2,7,3,6

d) For sixteen seeds the draw shall be split into sixteen sections. Each seed shall be placed at the top of a section in the following order:

- 1,16,8,9,4,13,5,12,2,15,7,10,3,14,6,11

9.05 Each player may only be entered into the draw once.

9.06 There shall only be one draw for opponents.

9.07 The draw for all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall be made once entry to a tournament has closed and the seedings have been allocated.

The complete draw for all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall be made available on the date specified within the Tournament Information and at the venue at the earliest opportunity.

9.08 Where required, byes shall be allocated throughout the draw in the following order:

a) Byes shall be allocated to seeded players, starting with the number one seed, and working down in numerical order to the last allocated seed.

b) All remaining byes will be randomly distributed throughout the draw.

- 9.09 Where it is recognised that seedings have been incorrectly allocated, the Tournament Organiser shall manually adjust the draw to ensure seeds are correctly allocated.
- Where it is recognised that a player should be seeded but is in the draw as an unseeded player, the Tournament Organiser shall manually allocate all players the correct seeding position with the incorrectly seeded player taking the place of the previously omitted seed.
- 9.10 Where it is recognised that a player or players have been omitted from the draw, the Tournament Organiser shall manually replace the bye(s), allocated in the draw with the omitted player(s) in the reverse order to which byes were allocated (see Clause 9.09).
- 9.11 Should any player withdraw or not attend to play in a tournament after the draw has been made, the position they held in the draw shall become a bye.
- 9.12 No substitutes shall be allowed in any WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
- 9.13 Under no circumstances shall players that have been beaten or eliminated from the tournament be allowed to re-enter the tournament in order to fill an empty place in the draw.

10. PLAYING RULES

- 10.01 WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall be played under the WDF Playing and Tournament Rules.
- WDF Playing and Tournament Rules can be found on the WDF website <https://www.dartswdf.com/rules/>.
- 10.02 Any additional rules created or practiced by the Tournament Organisers shall be approved by the WDF and published as a part of the Tournament Information.

11. PLAYING FORMAT

- 11.01 The playing format for all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall be 501, straight in, double out, unless otherwise approved by the WDF.
- 11.02 All WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments shall use the following playing format
- All Round Robin Group matches should be a minimum best of five, maximum best of seven.
 - All knockout matches up to and including the semi-finals should be a minimum best of five, maximum best of seven.
 - Finals should be a minimum best of seven, maximum best of nine.

12. PRIZE MONEY

- 12.01 Where applicable, total prize money levels for any WDF Youth Ranked Tournament shall be at the tournament organisers discretion.
- 12.02 The following criteria should be adhered to when establishing pay out levels for all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments:
- Total prize money shall not fall below the minimums agreed as a part of the application process but may be enhanced.
 - In both the boys and girls tournaments, Tournament Organisers shall determine the sum of prize money that tournament winners receive.
 - In both boys and girls tournaments semi-finalists shall receive prize money of circa 50% of the prize money awarded to the runner up.
 - The "circa 50%" rule shall then be applied to all further prize money pay outs.

- 12.03 All advertised prize money shall be declared before tax deductions.
- When taxed, Tournament Organisers must provide players with a legitimate tax certificate.
- 12.04 It is the WDF Member Darts Bodies responsibility to guarantee the payment of the declared prize money.

13. TOURNAMENT RESULTS REPORTING

- 13.01 All results from completed WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments must be submitted via the WDF Results App within 24 hours of the completion of the WDF Sanctioned Event.
- Tournament Organisers will be contacted in the lead up to tournaments regarding the use of the WDF Result App.

14. POINTS ALLOCATION

- 14.01 Points will be allocated for all WDF Ranked Tournaments based on the table below subject to the number of players entered into the draw.

- 14.02 All WDF Youth Ranking Points obtained in WDF Youth Ranking Tournaments will remain on WDF Youth Ranking Tables for 104 weeks (2 years) with the exception of the WDF Youth World Masters and WDF Youth World Championships, for which only the last edition shall be included in any WDF Youth Ranking Table.

15. WDF WORLD RANKING TABLES

- 15.01 All WDF Youth Ranking Tables shall be posted on the WDF website <https://www.dartswdf.com/tables>.
- 15.02 To be included in any WDF Youth Ranking Table a player must, at the time of issuing/updating the tables be an eligible Playing Member of a WDF Member Darts Body.

WDF Youth Main Ranking Tables

- 15.03 The WDF Youth Main Ranking Tables are two year rolling tables which carry the best ten points achievements by players, (Boys and Girls), across all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.
- 15.04 The WDF Youth Main Ranking Table shall be used to allocate seedings for WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.

WDF Youth Regional Tables

- 15.05 WDF Youth Regional Tables are two year rolling tables which carry the best eight points achievements by players, (Boys and Girls), from the specific region across all WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments played in the specific region.
- Points achievements from WDF Youth Major tournaments will not count on regional tables.

- 15.06 A Players nationality shall determine the country and therefore Regional Table to which they are associated.
- 15.07 In all WDF Youth Regional tables, Gold graded tournaments shall carry Silver graded tournament ranking points.
- 15.08 WDF Youth Regional Tables break down as follows:

WDF Youth Tournament Qualifier Tables

- 15.09 All WDF Youth Tournament Qualifier tables, (Boys and Girls), shall run for a specific qualification period for the named tournament and shall include the points achieved in the nominated WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments.
- 15.10 In all WDF Youth Tournament Qualifier tables, Gold graded tournaments shall carry Silver graded tournament ranking points.
- 15.11 Details of all tournaments that carry WDF Youth Tournament Qualifier tables shall be available on the WDF website, including tournament dates, qualification criteria and prize money.

16. CONDUCT

- 16.01 The WDF Executive have the power to discipline any Member Darts Body under the Disciplinary Code of Practice, which can be found on the WDF website <https://www.dartswdf.com/rules/>.

17. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

- 17.01 It is forbidden for any Youth player to drink any form of alcoholic beverage during a WDF Sanctioned Event.
- A WDF Sanctioned Event shall be interpreted as from the morning of the first event, (WDF ranked or otherwise), of the Sanctioned Event, until leaving the Sanctioned Event.
 - Random alcohol tests of Youth players may be taken during any WDF Sanctioned Event.

18. AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS

- 18.01 The WDF Executive reserve the right to amend, add to, or delete from any of the WDF Youth Ranking Systems Criteria at any time to meet any purposes deemed to be necessary.
Such changes may be made before, during or after a WDF Youth Ranked Tournament.
- 18.02 All questions or queries concerning individual WDF Youth Ranked Tournaments should be directed to and addressed by the Member Darts Body responsible for the tournament.
- 18.03 All questions or queries concerning the implementation of the WDF World Youth Ranking Systems Criteria should be addressed to the WDF Administrator via the WDF Contact form available on the WDF website <https://www.dartswdf.com/federation/wdf-contact-form/>.
- 18.04 In darts events under WDF jurisdiction all players and officials are subject to the terms and conditions of the WDF Anti-Doping Rules. Players are subject to testing that can take place in, or out-of-competition. In-competition sample collection could occur at any event as required by WDF.
